We had three amazing Aboriginal performers Uncle Matty Doyle and Brock and Bianca who did a incredible Aboriginal tradition dance performance. They mesmerized the crowd with their Didgeridoo performance and their Spirit, Crow, and Fishing dance! The crowd even got the opportunity to get up and learn the Ochre dance. The dancers really set the mood for day and brought the community together! Aunty Maxine also had set up a workshop for the kids doing rock paintings and Aboriginal art, it was a massive hit with the kids!

We were also fortunate enough to have Angela a local artist set up an amazing display about the importance of recycling and taught so much about what we can be doing as a community with our plastics and how recyclable art can be therapy.

Centrelink public holiday closures, reporting and payment arrangements

Centrelink is closed during the following dates:

Monday, 27 December 2020.

Tuesday, 28 December 2020.

Wednesday, 29 December 2020.

Monday, 03 January 2021.

You can use your Centrelink online account through myGov to:

- Report your income.
- View your reporting dates for the next 12 weeks.
- Change some of your appointments.
- Apply for an advance payment.
- Request a document.

You can also use Express Plus mobile apps and phone self-service.

You can still report your income to Centrelink, even when they are closed. However, if you do this on a public holiday Centrelink will pay you after the public holiday.

You can view your reporting dates 12 weeks in advance online. You can do this in your Centrelink online account through myGov or the Express Plus Centrelink app.

If you don't have one, you can create a myGov account. You can still report your income to Centrelink, even when they are closed.
